### Technical Support

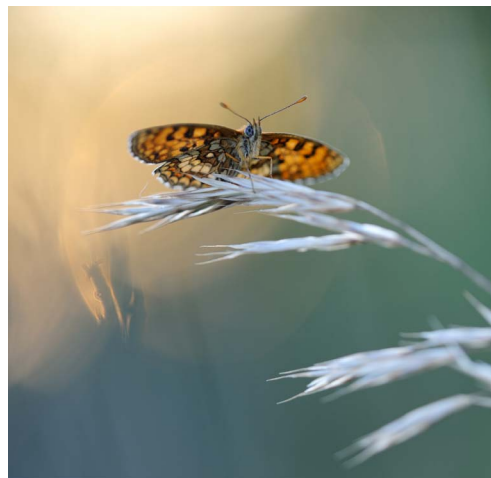

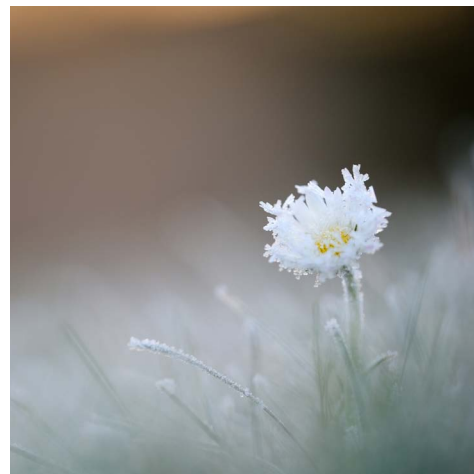

### Workshops and trainings

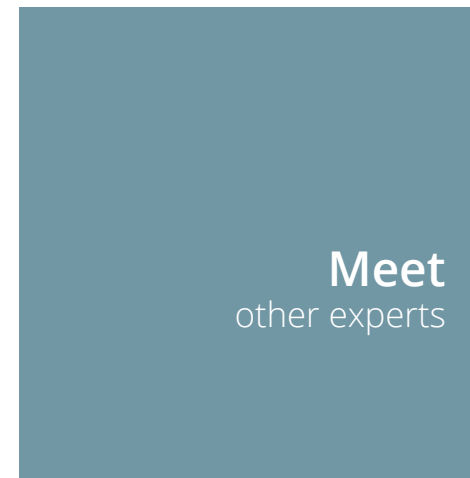
