## Context:

- *International*: CBD, CITES, RAMSAR, CMS, ... + EU
- *National*: National strategy on biodiversity: actually in revision (Aichi targets, EU biodiversity strategy to 2020, Europe2020 and its flagship on resource efficiency, ...)
- *Federal*: Federal plan for the integration of biodiversity in 4 federal key sectors (Economy, Development cooperation, Science policy, Transport)



## Federal level - actually

### 3 Federal action plan – Chapter Economy

- Sustainable policy on IAS, CITES
- 2 studies (in progress) - “Economic transition: the consumption and production patterns: incentives for key market players to integrate biodiversity”

‘Biodiversity’ → mainly sustainable use of **biodiversity, ecosystem and ecosystem services (BES)**

>< conservation of biodiversity (species and habitats)  
(excepted for marine environment)

- 1<sup>st</sup> study: ‘Offer’ study

Key objectives – common/main theme:



- ❖ Changing patterns of consumption and production in order to preserve biodiversity
  - ❖ Maintain and enhance the goods and services provided by ecosystems for the Economy and Society

- 2nd study: ‘Demand/consumer’ study

- Knowledge (scientific, economic, ...)
- Methodologies
  - > cost of inaction
  - > socio-economic importance of BES


Possibility to use scientific data to develop policy
