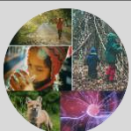

One Health in teaching and research

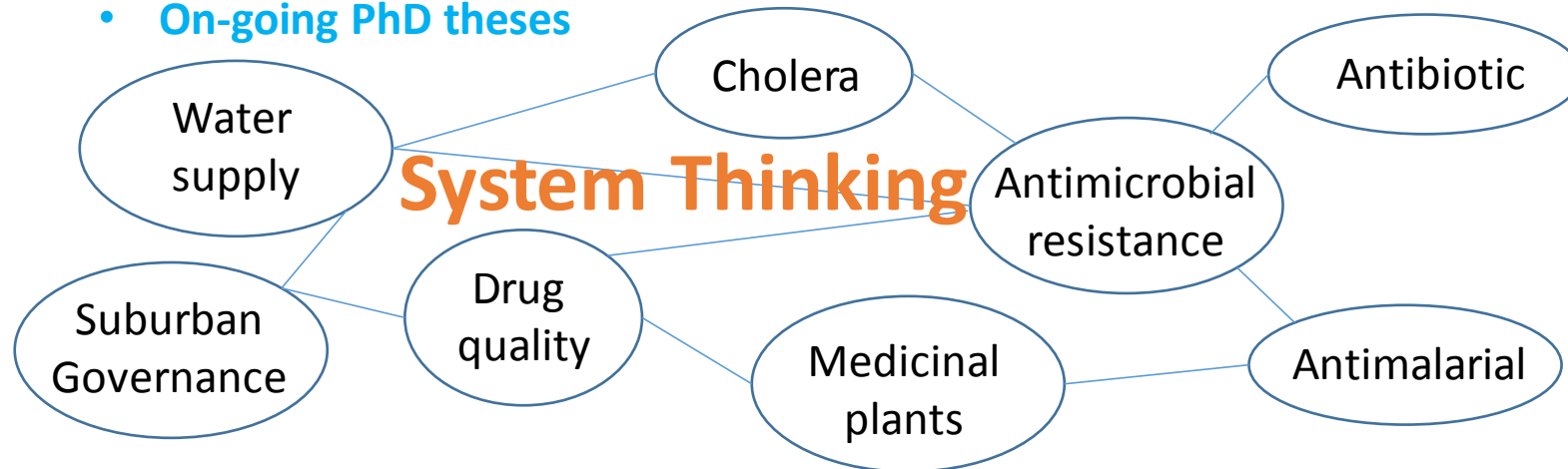




- **Master One Health (120 credits, 2 years)**
 - Faculties of Veterinary medicine, Medicine, Bio-engineering, Sciences
 - Starting in September 2020 with 2 orientations, infectiology and food safety
- **University certificates (10-20 credits, adapted schedules)**
 - Environmental health and ecosystem approach to health (15 credits, since 2018)
 - Methods and practice of interdisciplinarity in health (to be launched in 2020)
- **Medical humanities (research for tomorrow's teaching)**
 - Insertion of humanities and arts, social sciences, health policy, medical education, patient experience... deep into the medical practice and knowledge
- **One Health in basic curricula**
 - Veterinary medicine: first year course "Animals, Health & Society" (4 credits)
 - Master in Public Health: Introductory course on One Health (2 credits)
- **A set of complementary International specialized masters**
 - Integrated Management of Health Risks
 - Management of Risks and Disasters
 - Management of the environment
