All participants to the workshop need to be registered as expert reviewer for the FOD IAS assessment. Please complete the registration well before the meeting, following these 3 steps:

- 1. Make sure you have an <u>IPBES website user account</u> and be logged in on <u>IPBES.net</u>. Please note that the account verification process can take up to 24-48 hours.
- 2. Once you are logged in, register to become an IPBES external reviewer for the FOD IAS assessment here;
- 3. After registering, you will receive an email (within one business day) providing confidential access to the assessment and the template to use to provide your comments.
