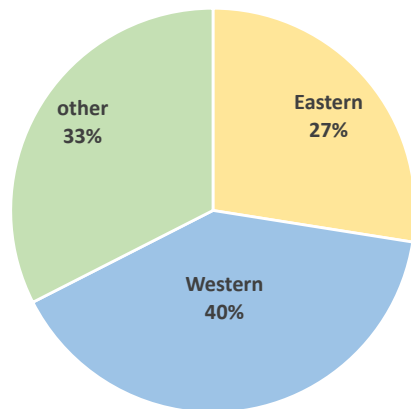

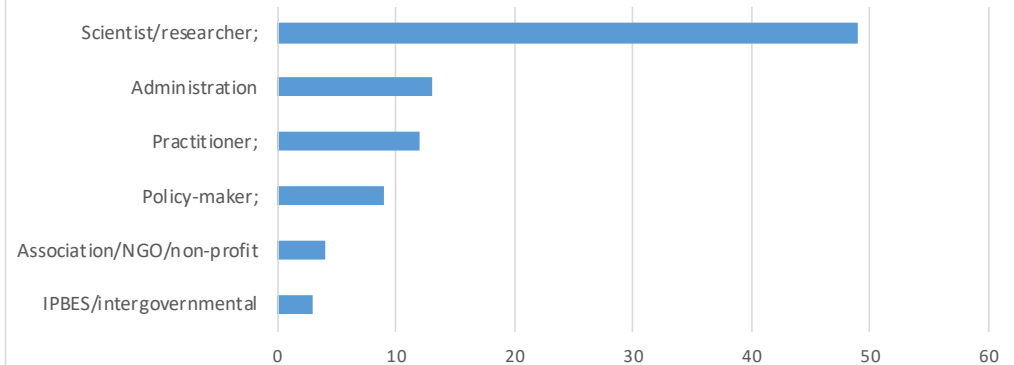

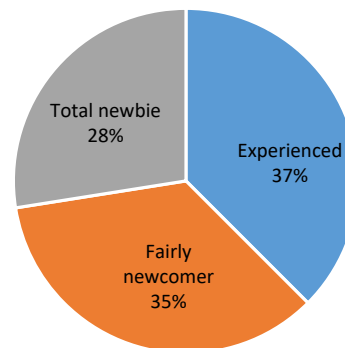
Region of origin of participants
