#### **Policy recommendations**

Facilitate one integrated One Health coordination across ministries & regional competences

Embed One Health as a principle in law and policy

instruments. E.g. in Strategic & Environmental Impact

Assessment & in the Aarhus Convention.

In One Health attention should be equally dedicated to respecting and improving human, animal and plant

health, and the environment.





### Science recommendations

Operationalize & support transdisciplinary practice oriented One Health science, involving diverse scientific disciplines and societal groups

Operationalize & support pro-active One Health science;

e.g. regarding prevention & neglected issues in health,

agriculture, biodiversity, environment, etc.

Operationalize & support One Health data sharing

between scientists

Include a holistic One Health approach in the curricula

Facilitate inter university One Health education

Operationalize & support One Health in spatial planning and preventative healthcare

Operationalize & support One Health literacy (education, media, involvement of target groups, communication of concrete examples of how system changes come together (flooding/nature based solutions), long life learning) Harness fair treatment of vulnerable groups in the framework of One Health, aim at decreasing health inequalities

Operationalize & support One Health bottom up

approaches - co-creation





**Belgian One Health network (BEOH) recommendations** 

Initiate a Belgian One Health knowledge centre as part of BEOH

Organize capacity commitments from universities and knowledge institutes for BEOH
