Data availability

Per phylum

Occurrences data available on the country are split down into phylums: Animalia, Plantae, Fungi, Unknown, Protozoa, Bacteria, Virus, Chromista, Archaea.

We compare percentages of data available for each phylum and rank these percentages for the five countries.

- Belgium is first (relatively more data available) for Animalia phylum.
- Belgium is last (relatively less data available) for Plantae, Fungi and Virus.

Taxonomic groups

Occurrences data available on the country are split down into these taxonomical groups: Mammals, Birds, Bony fish, Amphibians, Insects, Reptiles, Molluscs, Arachnids, Flowering plants, Gymnosperms, Ferns, Mosses, Sac fungi and Basidiomycota.

Data availability

Total data available for selected taxonomic groups in Belgium



We compare percentages of data available for each groups and rank these percentages for the five countries.

- Belgium is first(relatively more data available) in Birds and Arachnids data. Belgium is second in Bony fish and Mosses
- Belgium is last(relateivly less data available) in Mammals, Amphibians, Reptiles, Molluscs,
 Flowering plants, Gymnosperms, Ferns and Sac fungi

Top data contributors

Data available on Belgium is mostly coming from Belgian publishers(97,47%), the rest of data is coming from abroad.


• This place Belgium on the second position. Only the Netherlands publishes a bigger proportion of data on its own country(97,55%).

Data Repatriation

GBIF defines data repatriation as publishing data on other countries.

Data mobilization

Data sharing with country or area of origin by national institutions in Belgium



Belgian publishers publish mostly(89,06%) on their own country and rarely(10.94%) on other countries.


This gives us the last position for data repatriation.


Data Usage

Here we look at data downloads, peer-reviewed articles in 2021. In absolute numbers, Belgium comes to third and fourth position, but this is strongly biased by the country size.

Access and usage

So we measure relative numbers (per GDP and Population) and the results are very good:

• Belgium is first in downloads and peer-reviewed per GDP and per population.

Data Mobilization effort

Here we look at overall data mobilization efforts in the countries, and again, we compare relative numbers (per GDP and Population).

- Belgium is leader in term of data per GDP.
- Belgium is third in term of data per population, Luxembourg and the Netherlands are doing better, France and Germany are doing less.

Data Publishing types

Here we look at the basis-of-record of all occurrences published by the countries.

- Belgium is leader in machine observation and material sample.
- Belgium is last in human observation and fossil specimen.

Data with Medias

Here we look at occurrences with media(Image, Video, Audio).

Belgium has middle position (third or fourth).

Data Licences

Here we look at data Licences(CC0, CC-BY, CC-BY-NC) of published occurrences.

Belgium publish relatively more CC-0 data (second position) and less CC-BY or CC-BY-NC.

Historical data

Here we look at the years of occurrences.

- Belgium is leader in recent data (since 2000).
- Belgium is last in historical data (before 2000).
