# PREZODE: A COMMON FRAMEWORK TO FOSTER COLLABORATION AND IMPACT

To take up the challenge of preventing pandemics, the **initiative was launched in January 2021 during the One Planet Summit**, with the support of the European Commission and the Quadripartite (FAO, WHO), WOAH, and UNEP).

- **A common framework to implement and coordinate** research projects, surveillance systems, and operational projects to maximize their impact.

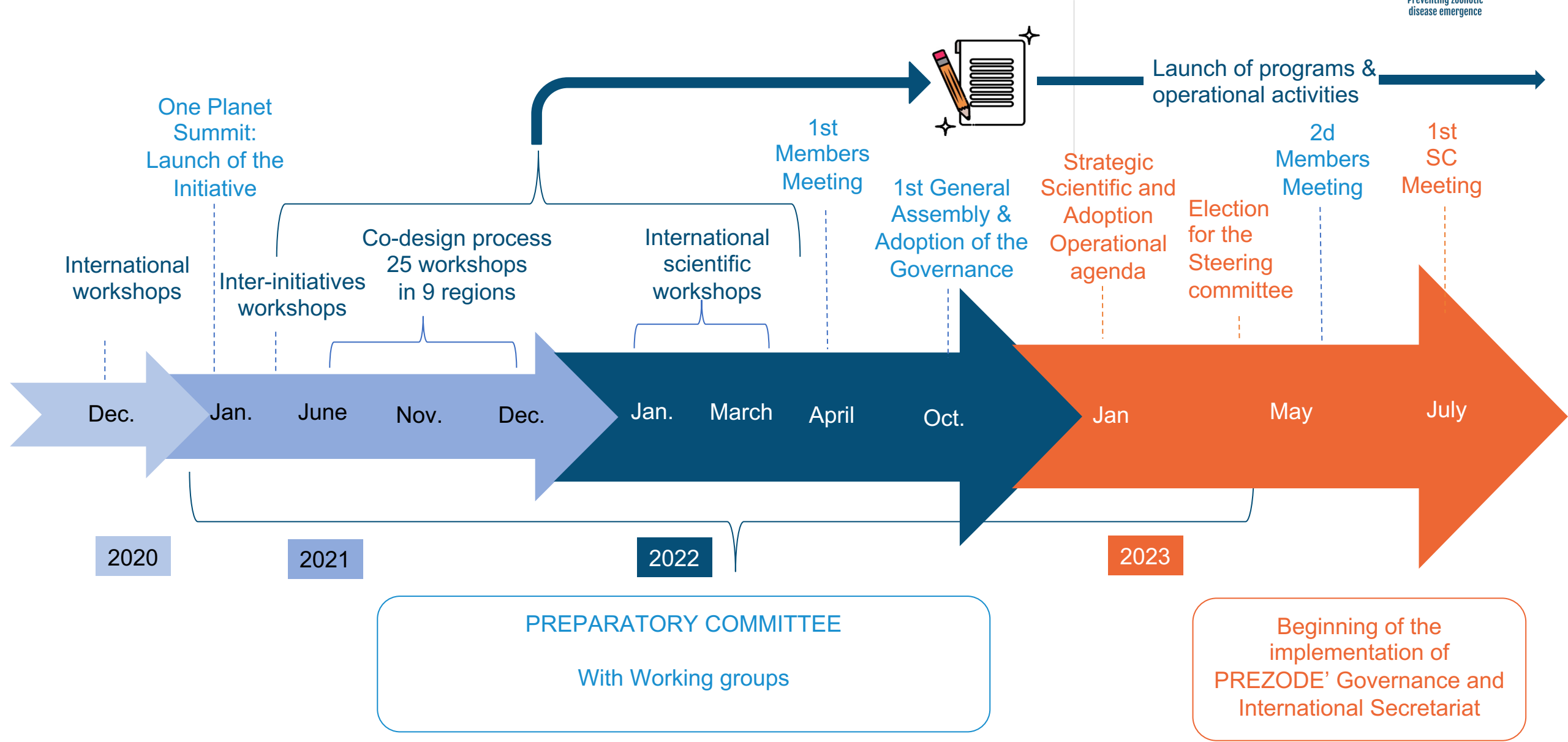


- **A platform for data sharing**



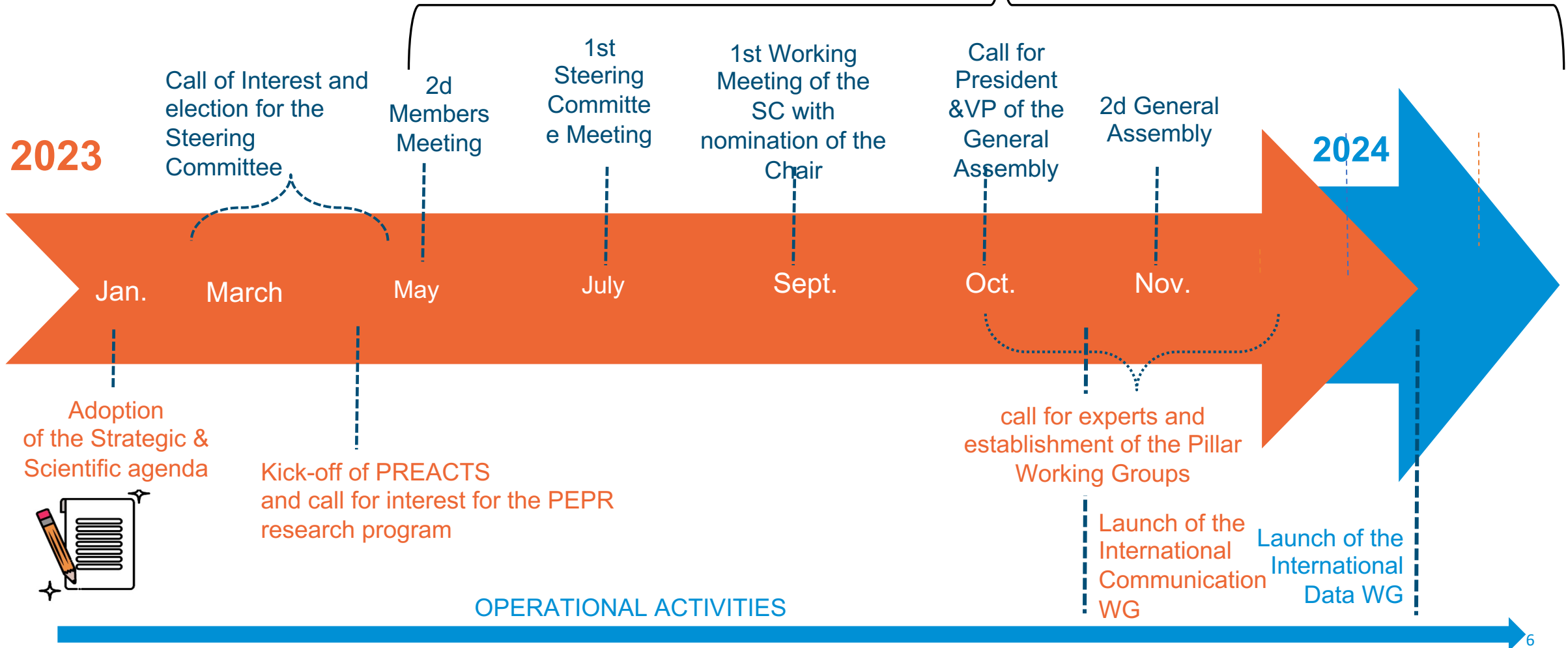
- **A resource center for decision-making,** to support evidence-based choices and policies to reduce the risk of emerging zoonosis.

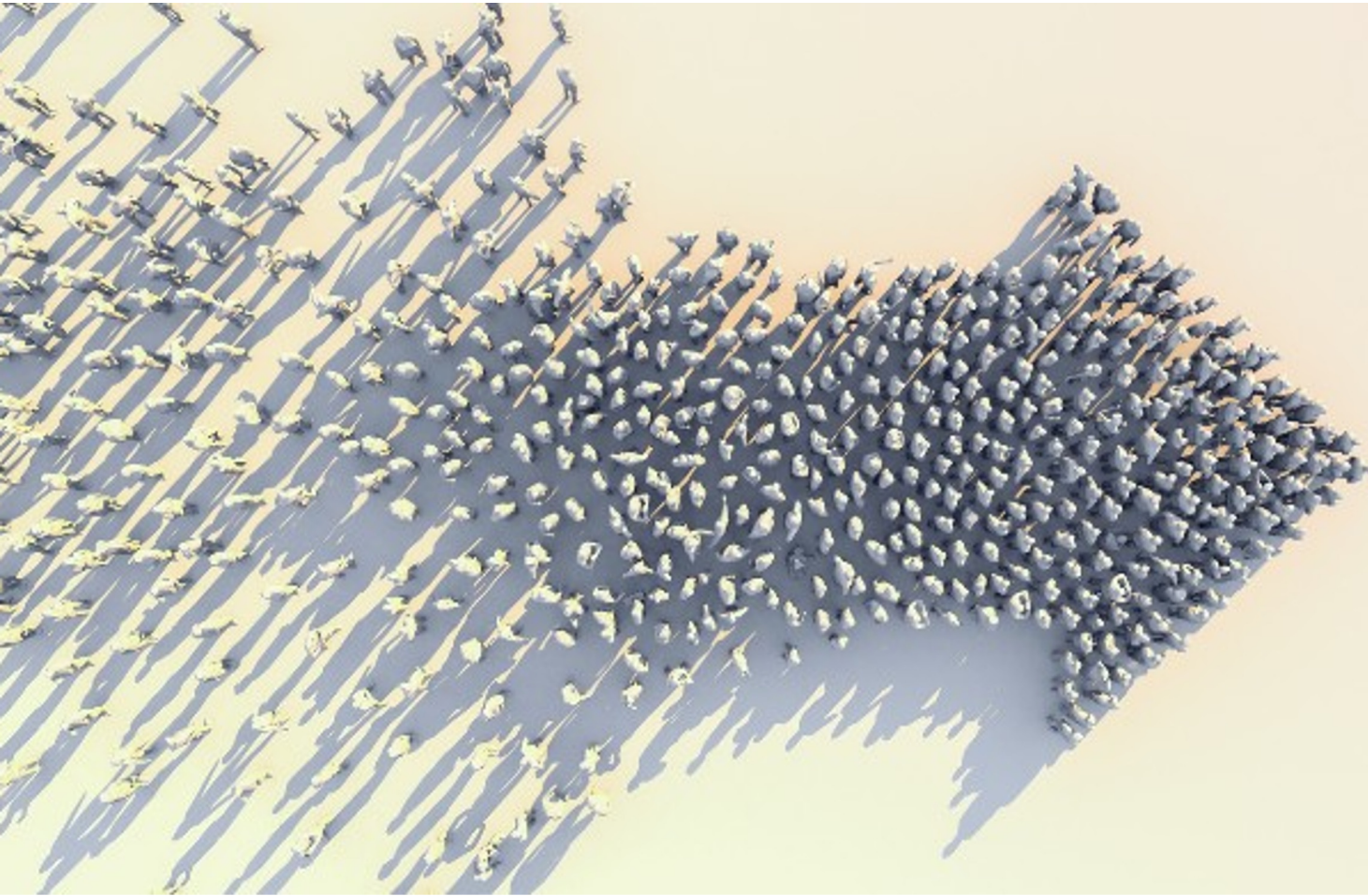

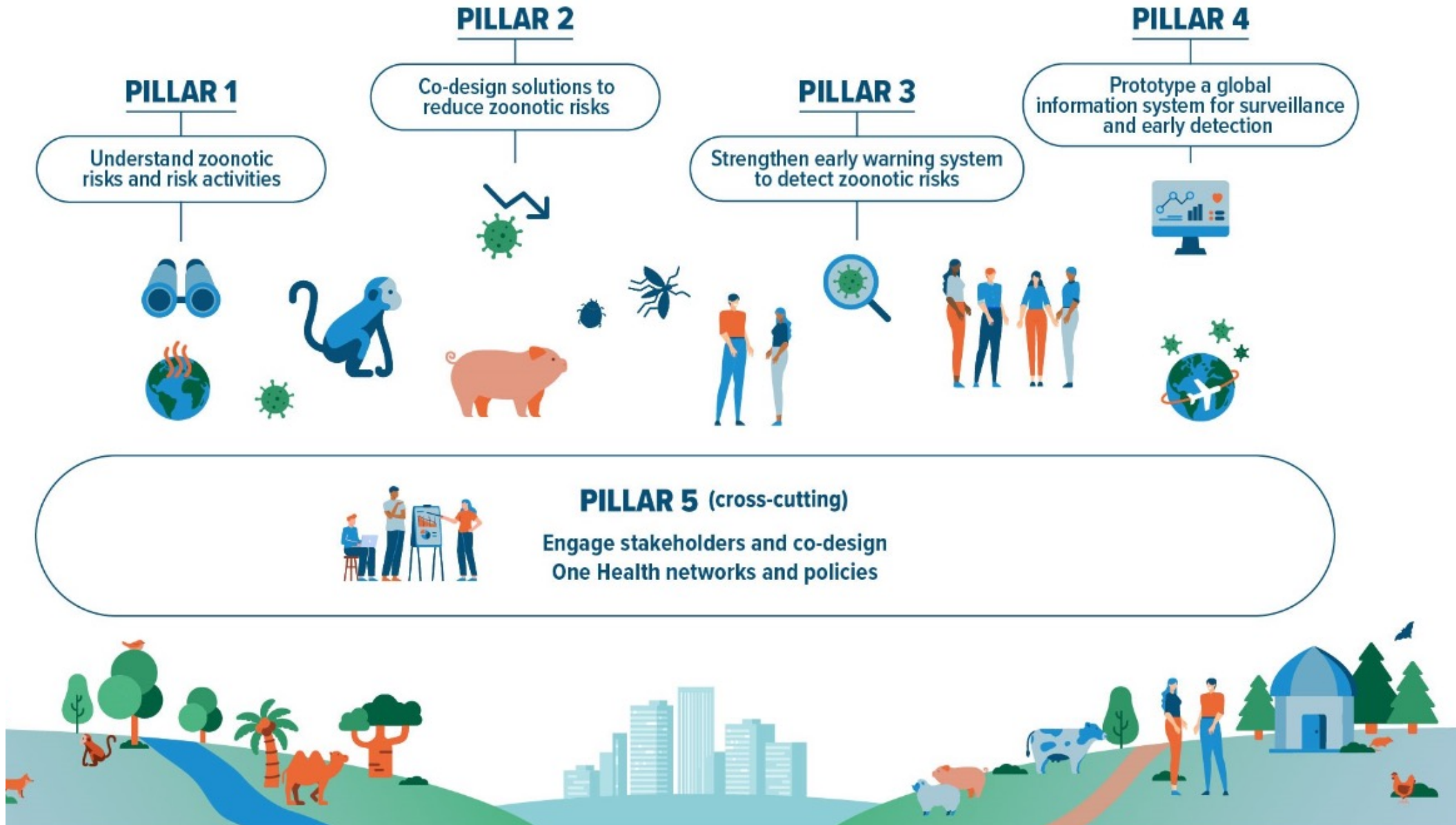

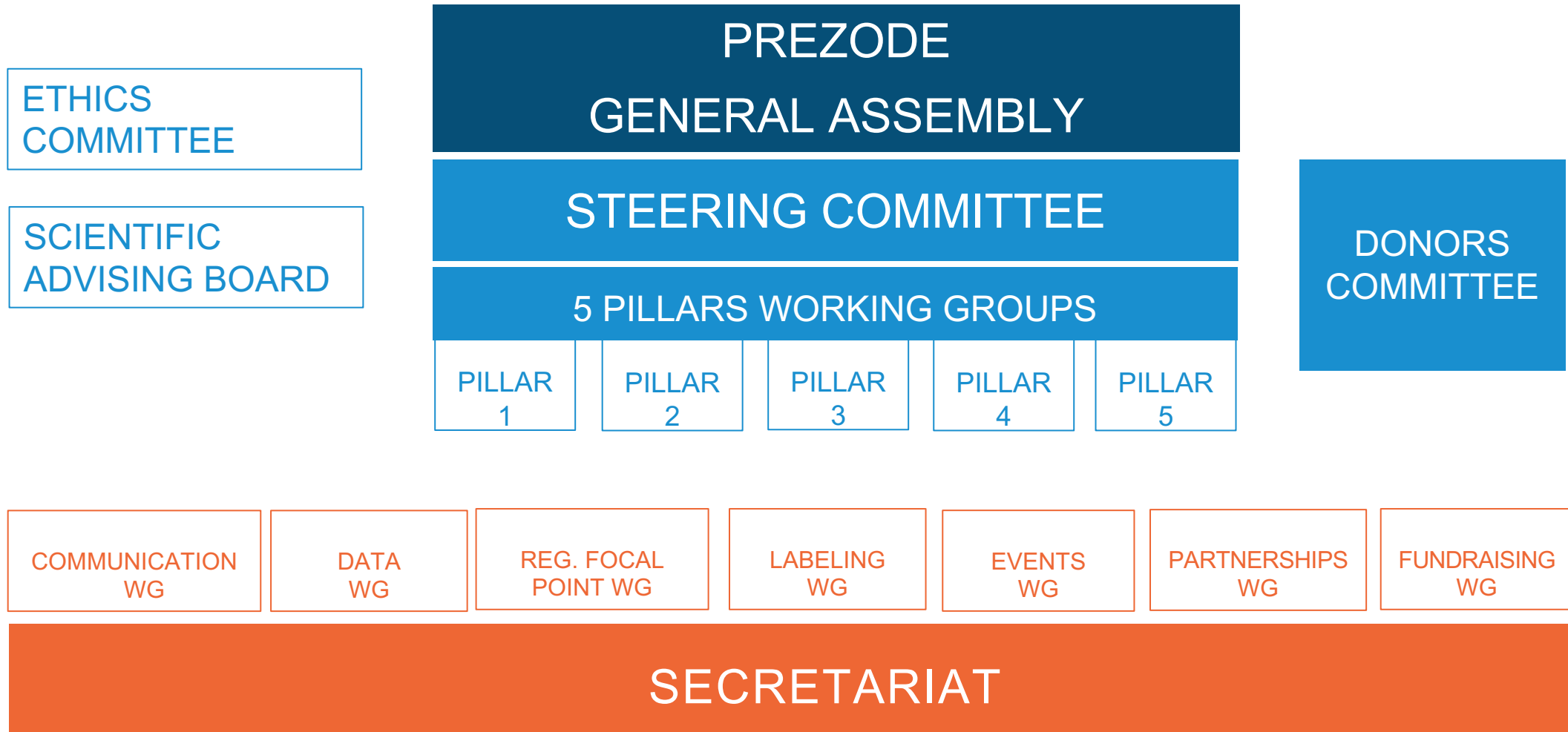

## THE ELECTION PROCESS FOR THE PRESIDENT AND VICE PRESIDENT OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY (GA)

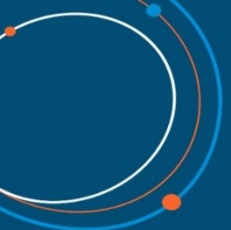
- Application submission: **15<sup>th</sup> October 2023.**

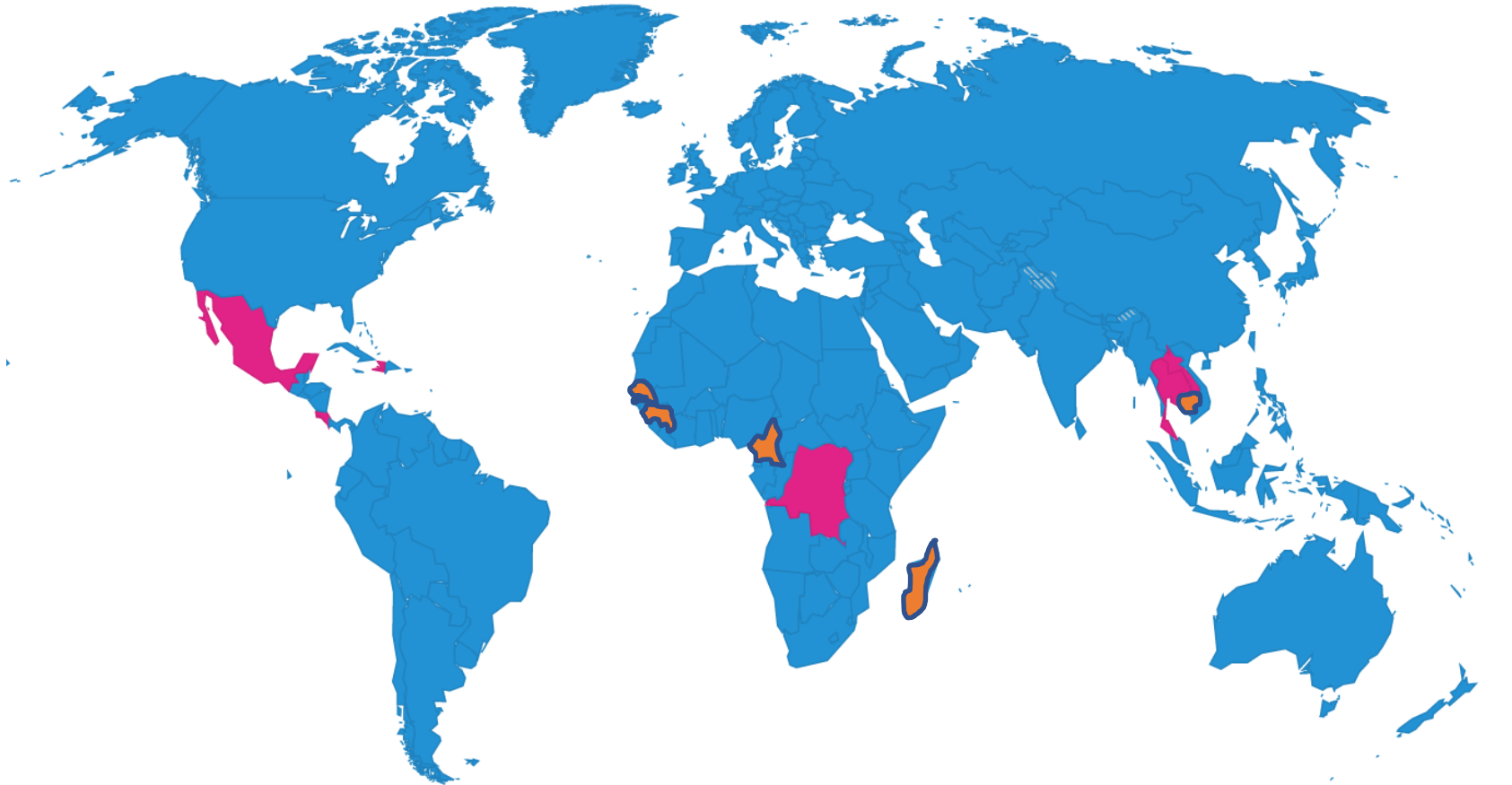
- First operational project of PREZODE towards countries in the Global South

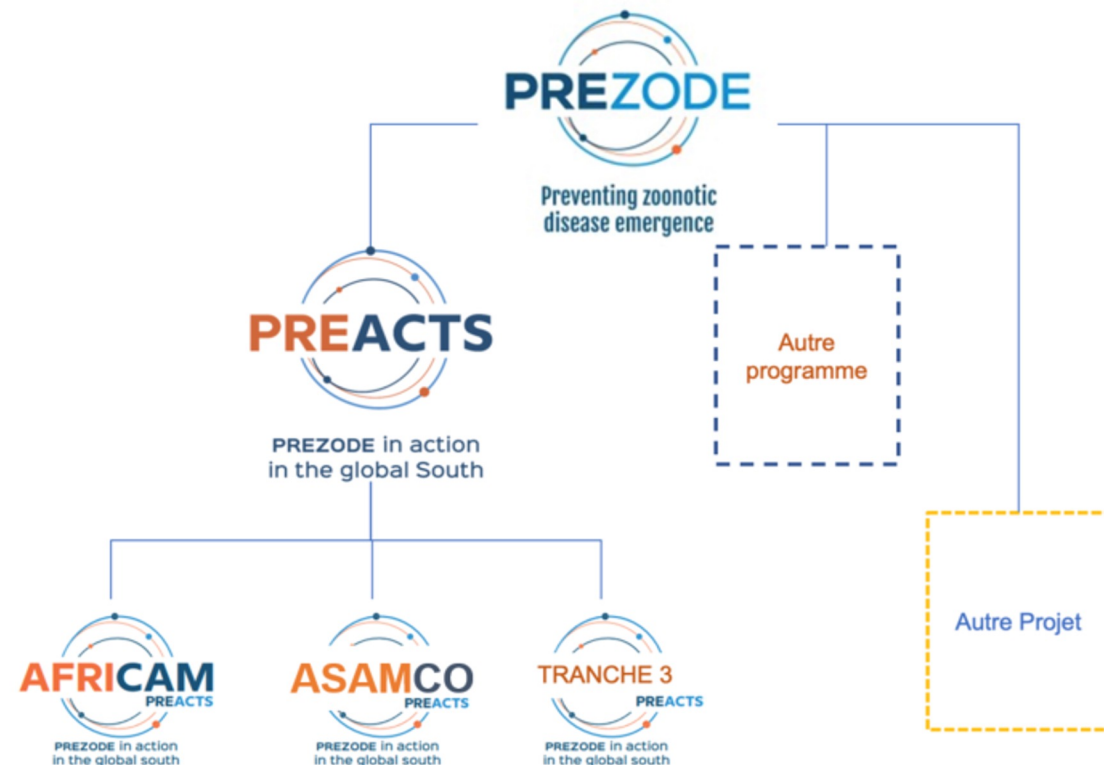
## 1. AFRICAM (1st part)

## 2. ASAMCO (2<sup>nd</sup> part)

- The Octroi committee is scheduled for the 18th of October 2023
- The Subvention committee is scheduled, in November 2023
- The beginning of activities is expected in early 2024



# Example for Community-based approach to environmental conservation and the prevention of pandemics

## “Participatory ecological monitoring”.

- Enhance monitoring systems by collaborating with local communities living near protected areas.
- Reporting any human activities that impact the environment (e.g. fires, illegal deforestation).
- Report any unusual domestic or wild animal deaths. The collected data will then be carefully analyzed.

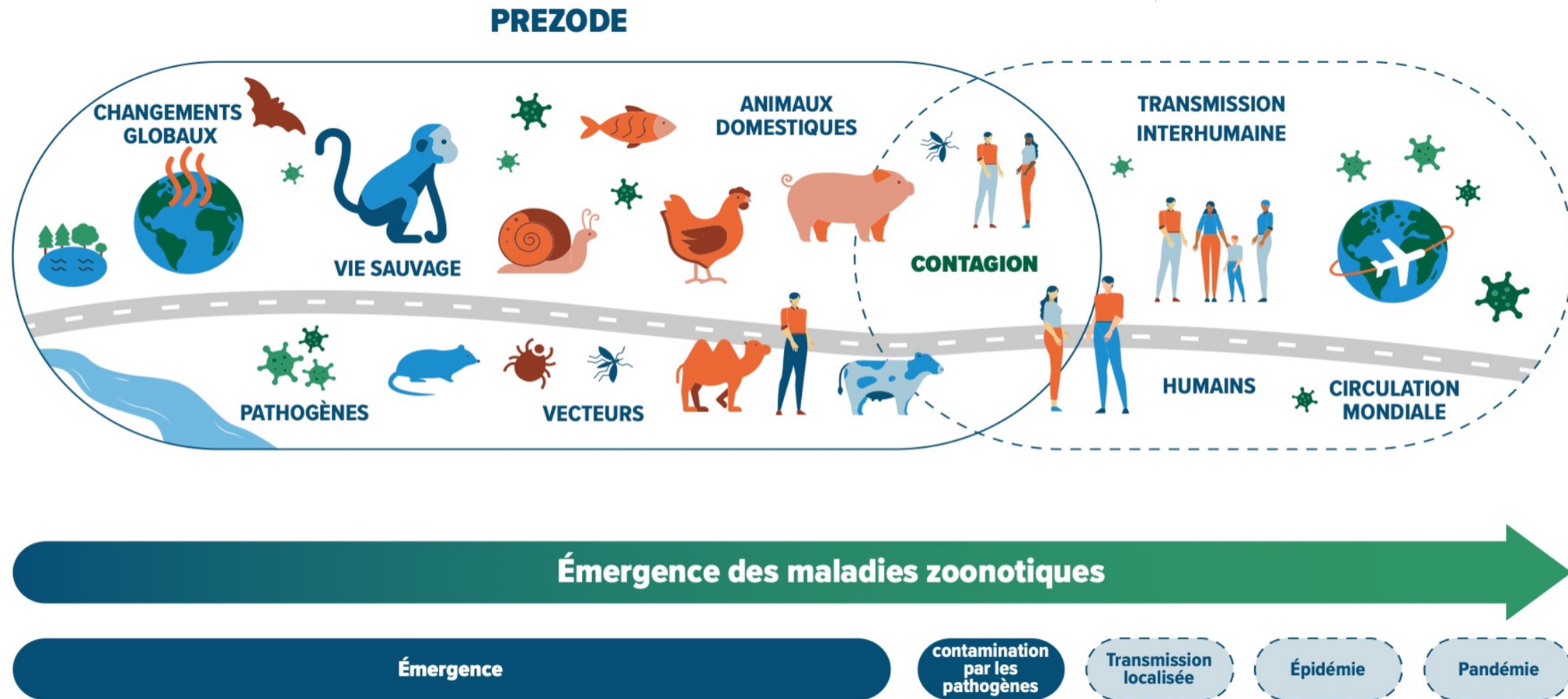

## PEPR PREZODE is structured around four calls for projects:

1. Understanding the intricate links between human activity and the emergence/re-emergence of zoonotic diseases.
2. Develop sustainable strategies to prevent the emergence of zoonotic diseases through innovative approaches such as ecosystem management and wildlife/livestock contact reduction.
3. Pioneering innovative methods to enhance pathogen surveillance and establish robust epidemiological networks in animals and at the animal/human interface.
4. Strengthening capabilities to detect and study potential zoonotic pathogens from various sources, including wildlife, domestic animals, and the environment.

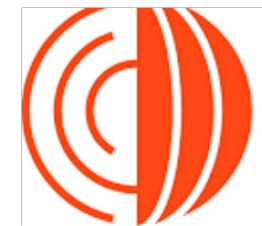

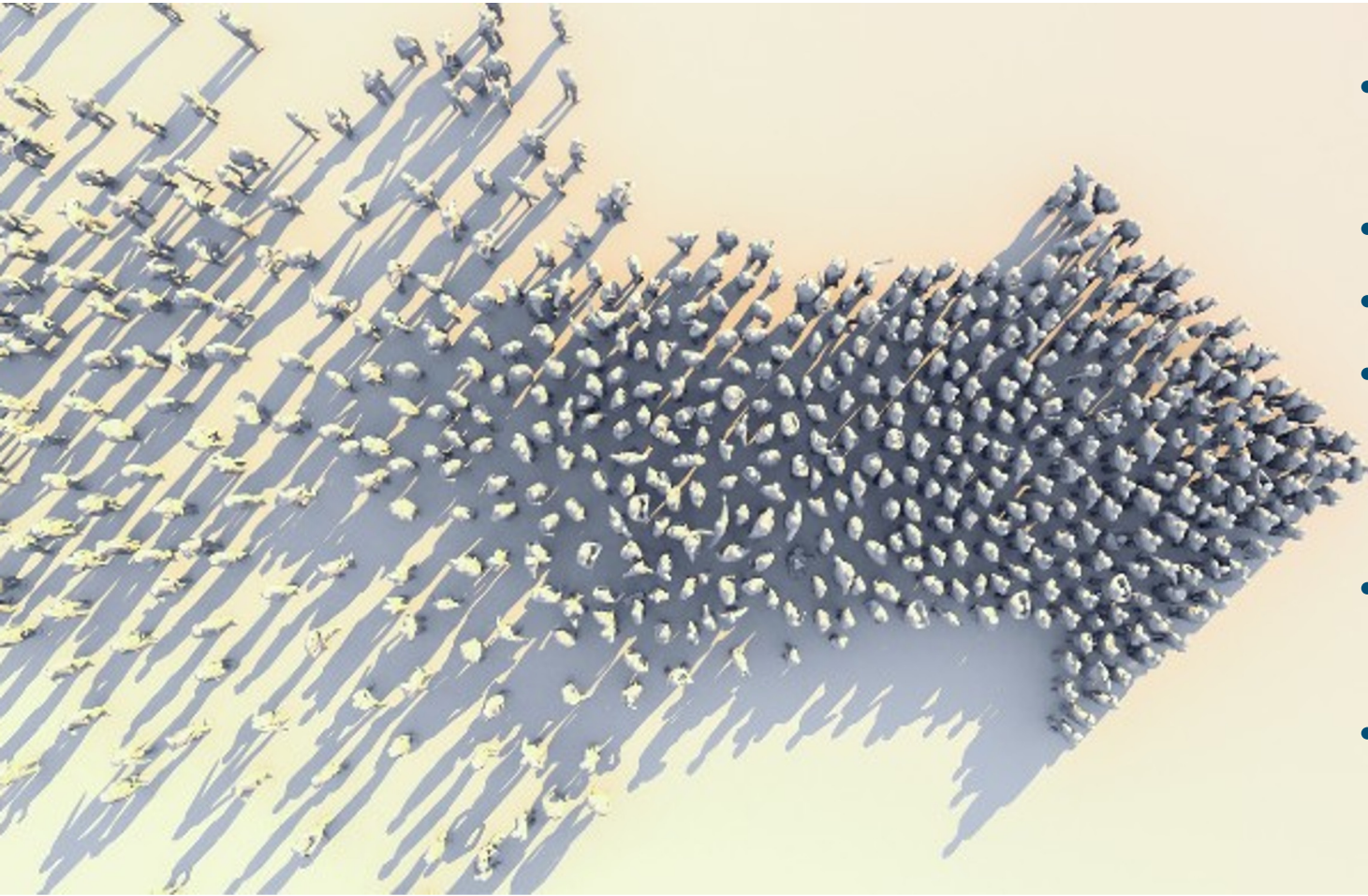

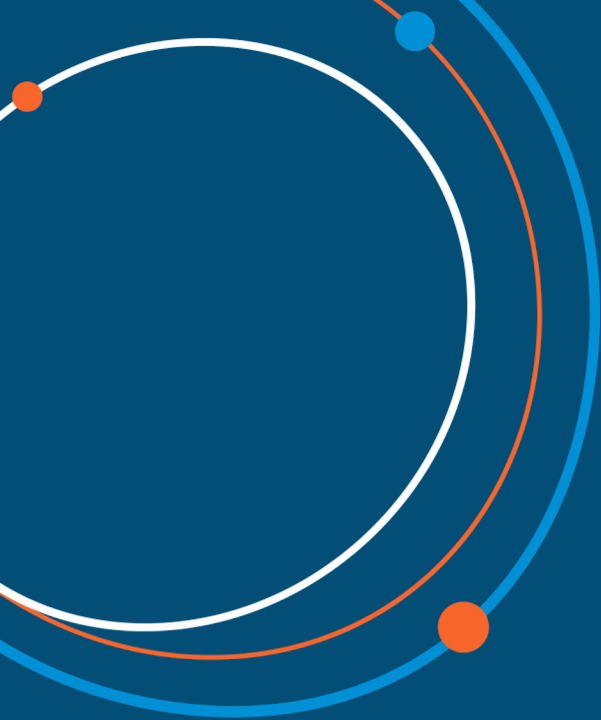
